

PROTECTIVE EYEWEAR

FOR SINGLES

Although the risk of injury in Squash is very low it is recommended that, when the avoidance of eye injury is of particular importance to a player, protective eye guards manufactured to an appropriate National Standard are worn properly over the eyes at all times during play. It is the responsibility of the player to ensure that the quality of the product worn is satisfactory for the purpose.

FOR DOUBLES
